The SMCS Band Booster general meeting was held on Tuesday, November 15, 2016 in the PHHS Band Room. In attendance: Kara Fairer - Vice President, Brenda Bankston - Treasurer, Pam Gust - Secretary, and many Booster members.

Call to Order/Welcome - Kara Fairer - 6:30 - The meeting was called to order at 6:37 pm.

Approval of Minutes - Kara Fairer - October Minutes

➤ Approved by: Becky Ireton Second by: Patty Lovins All in favor. None opposed.

Treasurer's Report - Brenda Bankston

- Checks and Payments: N/A . Deposits and Other Credits: N/A
- Ending Bank Statement Balance: \$17,832.25
- Register Ending Balance after Uncleared Transactions: \$3,555.18
- Fiscal Year: June 1, 2016 - May 31, 2017
- Per policy, the boosters keep the first \$3,000 of profit to cover startup expenses. After the initial \$3,000, the boosters keep 15% of all profit and transfer the other 85% to ECA.
- Checks written to ECA since last report: \$5,336.70. Checks written YTD: \$11,186.15. **Goal: 17,228.00**
- Booster profit (15%) since last report- \$150.53. Put into savings account for new uniforms/new trailer.
- New Savings account total for new uniforms/new trailer: \$1,250.20 (10% trailer/5% uniforms)

Band Director's Report

Mr. Taylor - PHHS - ECA Report, Trip Meeting, Percussion Recital, Jazz Band, Pep Band, I.P., Winter Guard, Christmas Concert, Solo/Ensemble, etc.

- ECA Ending Balance for October: \$10,419.97
- Student Accounts and Uniform Balance remained unchanged at \$401.09 and \$1,515.
- We had a successful marching band season. Thanks to all the parents who helped in any way. Due to the large turnout for awards night, we might want to think about a different venue for the 2017 awards night. The high school theatre will not be available. We may want to consider a banquet hall, more of a dress up event, catered meal, sell tickets, etc. Things to think about for the 2017 marching band season.
- Percussion Recital is Thursday, November 17, 7:00. Free Admission. Grades 6-12. PHHS Auditorium
- Marching Band Trip Meeting - same night, Nov. 17, 6:00. PHHS Band Room
- Solo and Ensemble Registration and Payment is due Tuesday, Nov 22.
- Holiday Concert is Tuesday, December 13, PHHS Auditorium. Any parent, family member, alumni, and staff are invited to play in the finale. Contact Mr. Taylor for music.
- A down payment of \$4,100 was recently made towards the purchase of new marching band bibs. Estimated Delivery: June 2017. Balance of \$4,100 due by delivery. At that point, all uniform pieces will have been replaced and should last 8 - 10 years.
The current jackets need to be dry cleaned by May 2017. Hold off on dry cleaning bibs till we get delivery date of new ones.
