

ISSMA SOLO AND ENSEMBLE SATURDAY, JANUARY 27, 2018

Location: Westfield High School

Times: Times are set by ISSMA and released about 2 weeks before the event. An approximate time range for the day is 8:00-4:00.

Fees: \$15 per solo, \$7 for each ensemble member

Selection of music: Directors can help you find any music you need. Please check with them early on. If you are taking a solo, your private instructor will help you find music. Each student is to make sure they will have an original of the music. There are three groups for high school:

Group I: Most challenging music- must come from a list (issma.net, resources, solo and ensemble manuals)

Group II: Medium difficulty- most sophomores/some juniors

Group III: Younger high school students/1st year participating

See a director for help in selecting a group level.

Accompanist: Solos should have a piano accompaniment. Please see a director for information and pricing on available people.

State Solo and Ensemble: Any student taking a group I solo or ensemble and receiving a gold rating will be eligible to go to the state competition. You must let Mr. Taylor know if you do not plan on going if qualified. Otherwise, you will be entered. Fees for state are the same price as district and are due the Monday after district.

Please fill out the Google form at phhsband.com and turn in money by Tuesday, November 21st. One form for each solo and/or ensemble should be filled out. Do not fill out more than one form per ensemble.

Requirements:

All Wind Ensemble members are required to participate in at least one event (solo or ensemble). Symphonic Band members are highly encouraged to participate. You may participate in up to four, with only one solo per instrument (i.e., piccolo and flute, trumpet and flugelhorn). Percussionists can take up to 4 solos.

All students in solo and ensemble will participate in the recital night at PHHS on Thursday, January 18th.
